

How to take a meter reading



Your fancy smart meter sends us readings automatically, so there's no need to worry about estimated costs. You'll always pay for what you use.

Sometimes though we might need to take a manual meter reading – we'll let you know if you ever need to – otherwise you can sit back, relax and let your smart meter do the work!

You can also use this guide to take a look at your day and night readings if you'd like – your Smart Display will show you your total usage under **'Meters'**:



To gain the night and day readings from the meter

Press **K1** or **K2** to wake the display and then **K1** or **K2** to enter into the menu.



Long press **K2** to go into 'General Display'



Short press **K1** and then Long press **K2** to go into 'Tariff Matrix'



Long Press **K2** to go into 'TOU Register'



'TOU Register' is the night usage, long press **K2** to go back to previous screen



Short press **K1** to move to 'TOU block register' and long press **K2** to enter



T1B1 is the total of the 1st KWH of each day charged at the higher rate



Short press **K1** twice – **T1B2** is the rest of the day KWH – Add together **T1B1** and **T1B2** to get combined day consumption

Important information

Long press: press button longer than 2 seconds

Short press: press button less than 2 seconds
